





13.05.2024 – Good Touch Bad Touch Activity


An awareness session helped children understand body safety through age-appropriate activities and role plays.

Students visited a nearby store, learning how transactions work and interacting with the store incharge to understand basic commerce.


29.07.2024 – Plantation


2. Solo Dance Competition




5. Drawing Competition


8. Rangoli Competition



11. Plantation Activity



15. Seed Ball Preparation – World Environment Day



16. Online Yoga Session – Yoga Day (Middle Wing)



20. Online Competition – “Honouring Hearts” by DWPS Kandaghat



24. Seed Ball Plantation Activity



32. Poster Making Competition



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


